Thank you for your gift of \$6,888.00 received with a postmark date of January 20, 2005 in support of American Red Cross emergency relief efforts to the victims of the recent earthquake and tsunami devastation. Your contribution will assist those throughout ravaged areas to gain stability by providing immediate relief assistance and long-term development assistance for the hundreds of thousands of people affected by this tragic event.

On Sunday, December 26, 2004, the largest earthquake to strike the globe since 1964 rocked the ocean floor off the coast of Indonesia. The 9.0-magnitude quake triggered giant tsunami waves that brought massive flooding and destruction, took more than 150,000 lives, and left hundreds of thousands injured, missing and homeless. As the death toll continues to rise at a staggering pace, the fear and risk of disease from contaminated water and food also grows.

The Red Cross responded immediately to this disaster, and is supporting this international relief operation with relief supplies, financial assistance and personnel. On January 7, the American Red Cross announced a multi-year plan of action to assist the victims of this disaster. The situation in the affected areas remains fluid and we will continue to assist this relief effort in every way possible to restore stability to the lives of these disaster victims.
